## RESOLUTION TO REDESIGNATE, RENUMBER AND RELOCATE

Arizona Department ORDWAY, Director, Transportation, has the 26th day of October, 1984, presented and filed with this Transportation Board his written report under Section 28-1864, Arizona Revised Statues, recommending the redesignation, renumbering and elimination of portions of U.S. Route 66, and the relocation of portions of U.S. Route 89 and U.S. Route 180, within the above-referenced projects.

The portions of existing state highways to be redesignated, renumbered and relocated are described and depicted in Appendix "A" and are more specifically delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Highways Division, Phoen1x, Arizona.

WHEREAS Interstate Route 40 has replaced U.S. Route 66 as the major interstate transportation facility, incorporating most of the U.S. 66 right of way into Interstate 40 right of way limits; and

WHEREAS the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has given its approval to the elimination of route designation U.S. |66; and

WHEREAS in order to provide the traveling public with a more uniform and simplified route numbering system, it is now necessary to redesignate and renumber portions of existing U.S. Route 66: therefore be it

## REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

## TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Highways Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the redesignation, renumbering, and elimination of route designations for portions of U.S. Route 66 and the relocation of portions of U.S. Route 89 and U.S. Route 180 within the above-referenced projects.

Interstate Route 40 has replaced U.S. Route 66 as the major interstate transportation facility in this area, with most of the U.S. 66 right of way incorporated into the Interstate 40 right of way limits. Therefore, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has given its approval to the elimination of the U.S. 66 route designation. However, prior to the elimination of the route designation U.S. 66, and in order to provide the traveling public with a more uniform and simplified route numbering system, it is now necessary to redesignate and renumber those portions of U.S. Route 66 which are not included within the right of way limits of Interstate Route 40.

Accordingly, I recommend that the portions of existing state highway U.S. 66 lying within Coconino County, from the Mohave County line easterly to the junction of Interstate 40 at the East Seligman Traffic Interchange, be redesignated and renumbered State Route 66.

I further recommend the additional designation and overlapping of State Route Business 40 over those portions of existing state highways U.S. 66 and U.S. 89 from the West Williams Traffic Interchange to the East Williams Traffic Interchange of Interstate 40; and that the aforementioned state highway U.S. 89 be relocated to overlap the portion of Interstate 40 between said West and East Williams Traffic Interchanges.

I further recommend the additional designation and overlapping of State Route Business 40 over those portions of existing state highways U.S. 66, U.S. 89, U.S. 89A, U.S. 180, and I-40 (signed U.S. 89-Spur) from the West Flagstaff Traffic Interchange to the East Flagstaff Traffic Interchange of Interstate 40.

I further recommend that the portion of existing U.S. Route 180, from the junction of U.S. 89 just west of the East Flagstaff Traffic Interchange extending easterly to the Walnut Canyon Traffic Interchange of I-40, be relocated to overlap I-40 between said East Flagstaff and Walnut Canyon Traffic Interchanges and over that portion of I-40 signed U.S. 89-Spur.

I further recommend that any remaining portions of existing U.S. Route 66 in Coconino County, which are not overlapped by Interstate 40, State Route Business 40, or State Route 66, be designated State Route I-40 Frontage Road.

The portions of existing state highways to be redesignated, renumbered and relocated are as described and depicted in Appendix "A", and are more specifically delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Highways Division, Phoenix, Arizona.
