WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made part of this resolution; be it further

RESOLVED that the portions of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" are hereby removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to the City of Page as provided in Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7207 and 28-7209, and effective upon recordation in the Office of the County Recorder in accordance with Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7213; be it further

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

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REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of portions of right of way acquired for State Route 89 Loop/Spur and Old State Route 98 within the above referenced projects.

The portion of State Route 89 Loop/Spur was previously established as a state route and a state highway designated U.S. Route 89 Spur by Arizona Highway Commission Resolutions 62-127 and 62-128, dated December 24, 1962; Resolution 68-5, dated February 21, 1968, established additional right of way and redesignated U.S. Route 89 Spur to State Route 89 Loop also known as State Route 89 Spur; thereafter various Resolutions established additional right of way.

The portion of State Route 98 was previously established as state route by Arizona Highway Commission Resolution 74-33, dated March 1, 1974; thereafter Resolution 74-67, dated May 24, 1974; established said route as a state highway.

Portions of the previously acquired right of way are no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of Page has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portions of right of way be abandoned.

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The portions of right of way to be abandoned are depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, PAGE LOOP; PAGE - JCT. U.S. 160 Highway, Projects S-559-601, F-041-701, M-839-1-701 / 089L,098CN000H088801R."

I further recommend that the portions of right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to the City of Page.

All other rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7210 shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.
