RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

VICTOR M. MENDEZ, Director, Arizona Department of Transportation, on April 20, 2007, presented and filed with this Transportation Board his written report under Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, recommending the abandonment of State Route 280 within the above referenced project.

The right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, AVENUE 3E Highway, Project S-280-A-800 / 280YU000H604201R."

WHEREAS said right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS this Board finds that public safety, necessity and convenience will be served by accepting the Director's report; therefore, be it

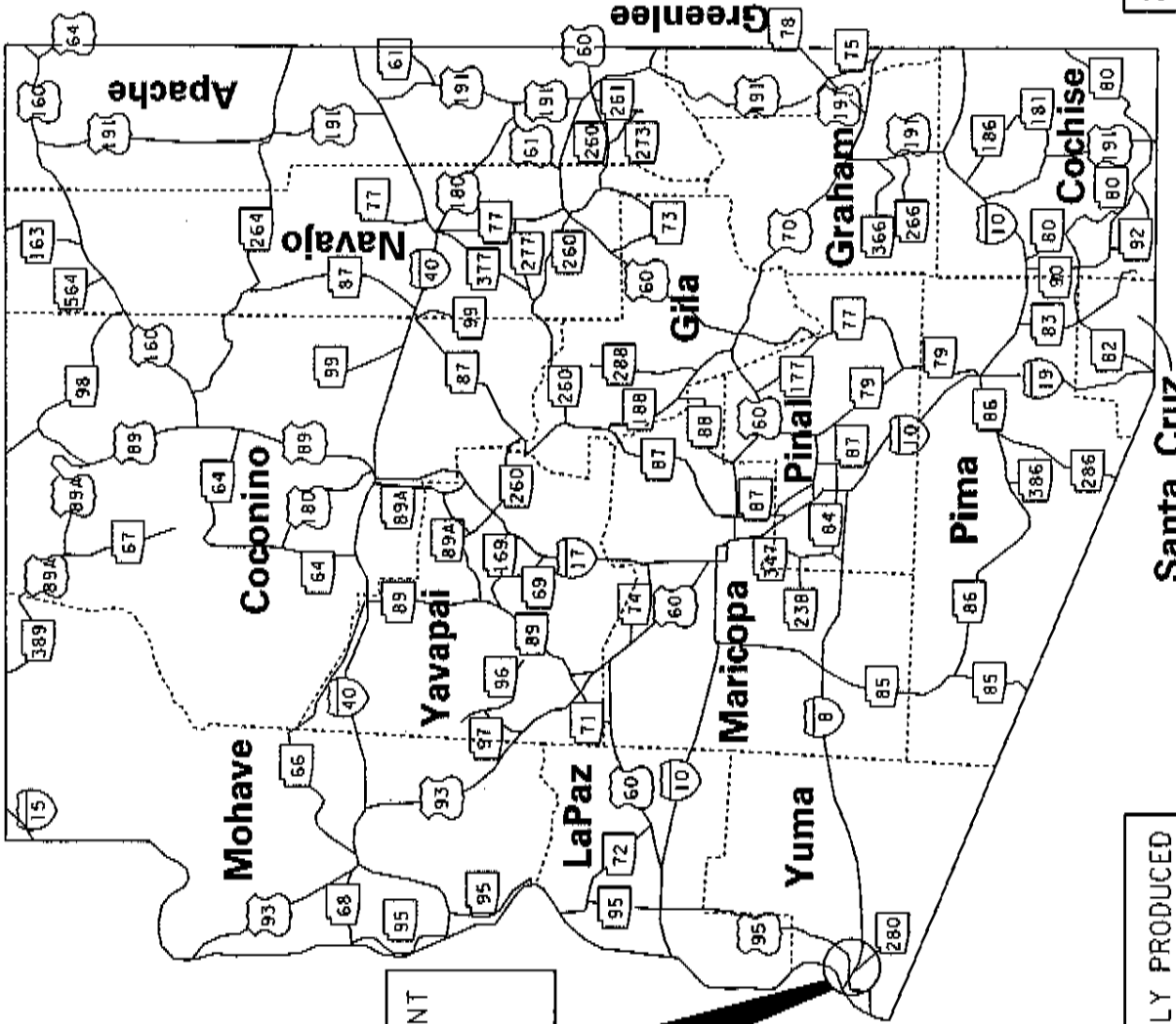
RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made part of this resolution; be it further

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RESOLVED that the right of way depicted in Appendix "A" is hereby removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to The City of Yuma for a continued public transportation use per Inter-governmental Agreement No. 02-207, dated May 11, 2004 and amended December 21, 2006, filed with the Secretary of State (unrecorded) as provided in Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7207 and 28-7209, and effective upon recordation in the Office of the County Recorder in accordance with Arizona Revised Statute Section 28-7213; be it further

RESOLVED that the Director provide written notice to The City of Yuma evidencing the abandonment of the State's interest.

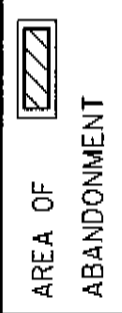

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REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Intermodal Transportation Division has made a thorough investigation concerning the abandonment of a portion of right of way acquired for State Route 280 within the above referenced project.

This portion was previously established as a state route and state highway designated State Route 280 by Arizona Highway Commission Resolution 68-36, dated May 17, 1968, pages 207-208 of the Official Minutes; Resolution 69-44, dated May 16, 1969, established additional right of way as a state route and state highway for improvements; and thereafter, various Resolutions established additional right of way for further improvements.

A portion of the previously acquired right of way is no longer needed for state transportation purposes. The City of Yuma per Intergovernmental Agreement #02-207, dated May 11, 2004 and amended December 21, 2006, filed with the Secretary of State (unrecorded), has agreed to accept jurisdiction of the right of way, for a continued public transportation use. Accordingly, I recommend that the State's interest in the portion of right of way be abandoned.

The right of way to be abandoned is depicted in Appendix "A" and delineated on the maps and plans on file in the office of the State Engineer, Intermodal Transportation Division, Phoenix, Arizona, entitled "Right of Way Plans, AVENUE 3E Highway, Project S-280-A-800 / 280YU000H604201R."

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
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I further recommend that the right of way depicted in Appendix "A" be removed from the State Highway System and abandoned to The City of Yuma.

All other rights of way and easements and appurtenances thereto subject to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7210 shall continue, as they existed prior to the disposal of right of way depicted in Appendix "A".

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 28-7046, I recommend that the Transportation Board adopt a resolution making this recommendation effective.


