WHEREAS the portion of the above referenced state route to be designated the Organ Pipe Cactus Parkway is a state highway; and

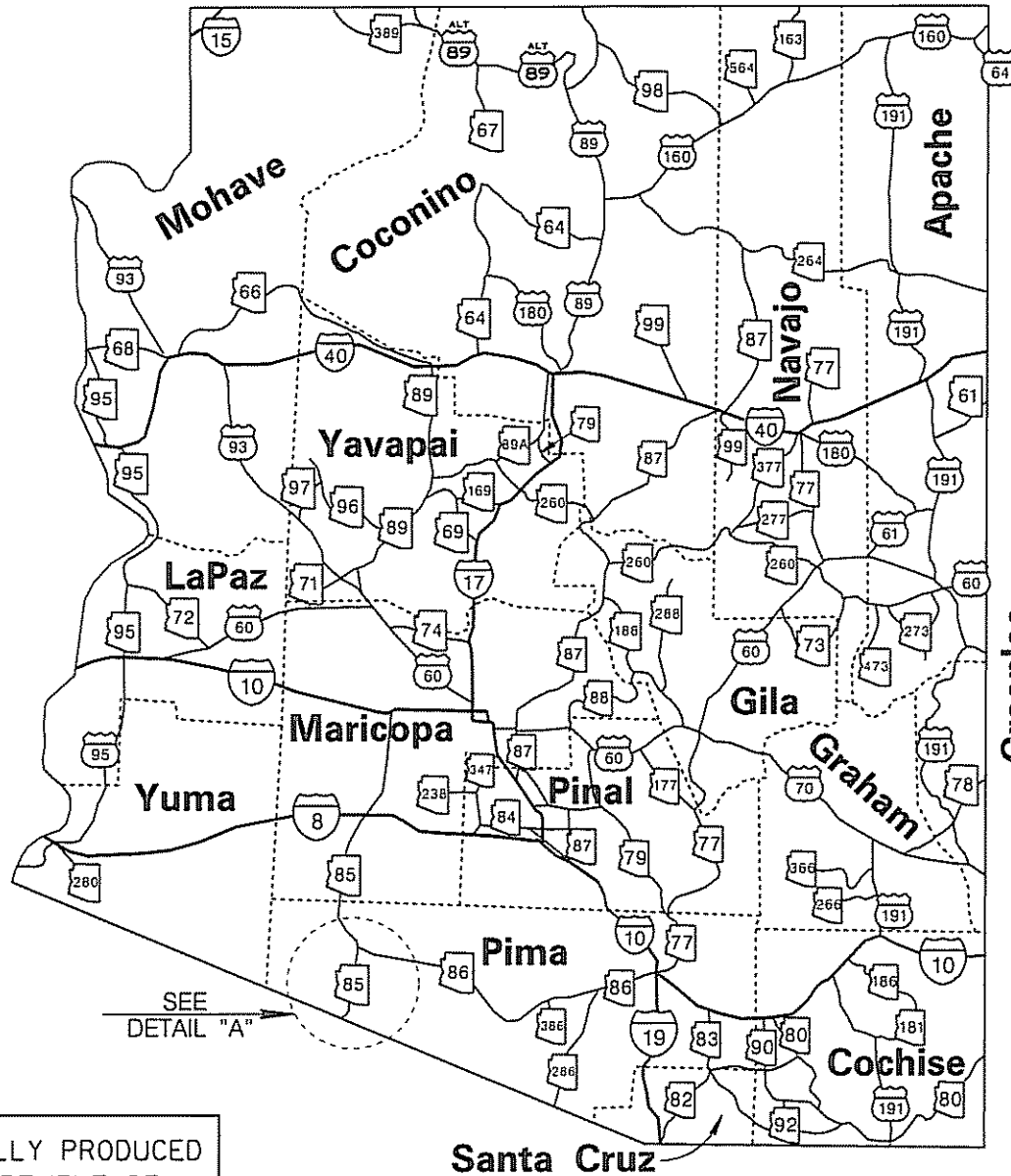

WHEREAS because of these premises, this Board finds that public convenience will be served by accepting the Director's recommendation; therefore be it

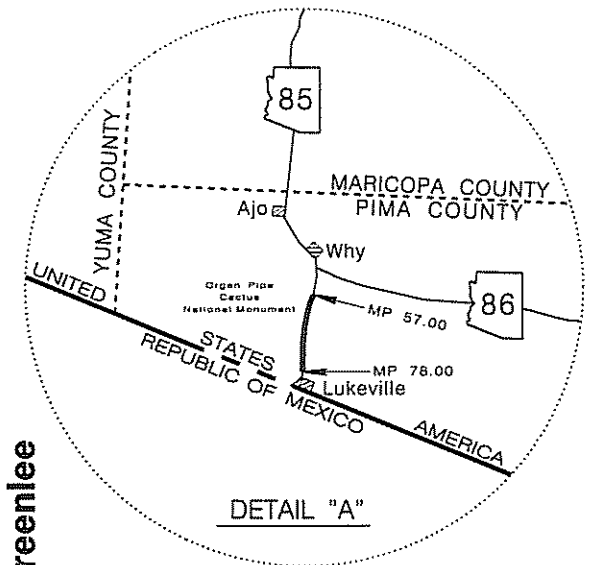
RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Director is adopted and made a part of this Resolution; be it further

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

TO THE HONORABLE ARIZONA TRANSPORTATION BOARD:

The Arizona Parkways, Historic and Scenic Roads Advisory Committee, established under Arizona Revised Statutes Section 41-514 and acting in compliance with Rule R17-3-804, has made a thorough investigation concerning the designation of a portion of State Route 85 from Milepost 57 to Milepost 78 as the Organ Pipe Cactus Parkway.

This portion was previously established as a state route and state highway by Arizona Highway Commission Resolution dated January 10, 1955, page 143 of the Official Minutes; thereafter Arizona Transportation Board Resolution 80-10-A-37, dated August 22, 1980, authorized documentation and acquisition of existing right of way; Resolution 2002-02-A-005, dated February 15, 2002, established additional right of way for improvements thereof.

The Arizona Parkways, Historic and Scenic Roads Advisory Committee has recommended that the portion of the above referenced highway be designated as the Organ Pipe Cactus Parkway as depicted in Appendix "A".

In the interest of public convenience and in concurrence with the Advisory Committee, I recommend that the above referenced portion of the state highway, as depicted in Appendix "A", be designated the Organ Pipe Cactus Parkway.


